

Kappl & See Ski Area: family fun and freeride adventures

The Kappl and See ski resorts in Paznaun are ideal winter destinations for skiers and snowboarders looking for a family atmosphere and varied pistes. Both resorts offer a perfect mix of family-friendly options and challenging runs for experienced skiers. With modern lifts, guaranteed snow and special freeride areas, Kappl and See are real insider tips in Tyrol.

Kappl and See together form the versatile Kappl & See Ski Area, which combines two ski areas in one. With a joint ski pass, winter sports enthusiasts have access to a total of 84 kilometres of pistes, which extend over easy and challenging slopes. Thanks to the north and south-facing slopes, the ski circuit offers continuous sunshine and guarantees perfectly groomed pistes – ideal conditions for leisure skiers and families. 20 lifts make it possible to reach the slopes quickly and easily, and a bus connection ensures that the two areas are easily linked so that visitors can enjoy the best of both worlds.

The six-kilometre-long toboggan runs in both ski areas, some of which are also open in the evenings every week, provide variety in everyday skiing. For peace and relaxation, choose one of the six winter hiking trails located in the ski areas.

Kappl ski area: versatility for families and freeriders

The Kappl ski area extends over 42 kilometres of perfectly groomed pistes and offers a wide selection of slopes for all abilities. Families with children will find gentle slopes for beginners, while experienced skiers and snowboarders can enjoy steeper and longer runs. The altitude of 1,180 to 2,690 metres guarantees snow throughout the season.

A special highlight for families is the Sunny Mountain Adventure Park, which is specially designed to meet the needs of children. Here, the little ones can make their first attempts at skiing under professional supervision. The mascot "Flaxi" provides additional fun, and there are numerous child-friendly attractions such as conveyor belts, playgrounds and a children's ski lift.

For adventurous winter sports enthusiasts, Kappl, also known in the scene as "Kapplaska", offers fantastic freeriding opportunities. Away from the groomed pistes, freeriders can enjoy unspoilt nature on the snow-covered slopes, which are up to 60° steep. The region offers various freeride routes from the 2,690 metre-high Quellspitze and the local mountain. Kappl attaches great importance to safety: there are special freeride zones and information on the current avalanche situation so that freeriders can set off into the unspoilt areas optimally prepared.

In January, the deep snow slopes of Kappl become the annual venue for the Open Faces and the Freeride Junior World Championships.

See ski area: family ski area with variety

The See ski area is particularly suitable for families with children who are looking for a clearly laid out and well-organised ski area. With 42.5 kilometres of slopes, See offers an ideal size for families to enjoy skiing without being overcrowded. The pistes are varied and offer enough variety for both beginners and advanced skiers.

See is known for its wide, easy-to-ski slopes, which are ideal for children and beginners in particular. The modern lift facilities ensure comfortable transport to the various slopes, and there is a special practice slope as well as ski schools that offer beginners' courses and children's ski lessons with the mascot "Seebi". In addition to the gentle slopes for families, See also offers more challenging slopes for advanced skiers. There are also several off-piste options to enjoy the powder on the freeride routes.

Comprehensive services for a carefree day of skiing

The Kappl & See Ski Area not only offers first-class pistes, but also a comprehensive range of services for a relaxing day's skiing. Well-equipped ski schools are available in both ski areas, offering customised courses for both children and adults. Those who don't bring their own ski equipment can benefit from ski hire, which provides state-of-the-art equipment for skiing, snowboarding and freeriding. The ski resorts also offer practical ski depots where equipment can be stored safely and conveniently. There is also a free ski bus service available to guests, which runs regularly between resorts in Paznaun.
