Kings of Leon to perform at Ischgl season final

Kings of Leon will perform at the grand finale of the Ischgl ski season 21/22. Winter sports enthusiasts will flock to see the American rock band live in the ski area on April 30 at the legendary "Top of the Mountain Closing Concert" at 2,320 meters above sea level. Concert admission is included in the day ski pass.

For the season finale on April 30, 2022, Multi-Platinum & Grammy award winning band, Kings of Leon will rock the "Top of the Mountain Closing Concert." The open-air concert on the legendary "Ischgl Stage" starts at 13.00. Expect a set with all the band's many hits and songs from all eight of their albums. Against the backdrop of the snow-covered Silvretta Arena, this will be a unique and certainly unforgettable concert experience. The day ski pass for Ischgl/Samnaun is also the ticket to the concert. 1, 2 or 3-day ski passes are available on site for 125, 140 or 160 euros with a guest card from the TVB Paznaun-Ischgl. For all other multi-day tickets, the regular ski pass prices apply. Kings of Leon are not only the grand finale to the Ischgl ski season but also the perfect finish of the new event series "Spring Blanc", which provides very special ski moments and a colourful program full of culinary delights and music April 2nd to May 1st. Since their debut in 2003, Kings of Leon ((Caleb (guitar/vocals), Nathan (drums), Jared (bass) and Matthew Followill (guitar)) have released eight albums (Youth & Young Manhood (2003), Aha Shake Heartbreak (2004), Because of the Times (2007), Only by the Night (2008), Come Around Sundown (2010), Mechanical Bull (2013), WALLS (2016), and When You See Yourself (2021)). The band has sold over 20 million albums and nearly 40 million singles worldwide. Known for their rousing live performances, Kings of Leon have headlined all the world's biggest and most prestigious festivals, including Glastonbury, Coachella, multiple Lollapalooza', Roskilde, as well as Rock im Park, Nova Rock and St. Gallen, to name but a few.
